## PRACTICAL INFORMATION

---

Due to city regulations, waste segregation is mandatory in our apartments in the kitchen, you will find lebeled bins.

At the entrance, you will find beach screens.

In one of the wardrobes, you will find an iron, ironing board and clothes dryer.

For your comfort, quiet hours are from 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM.

## SHOPPING

---

The nearest supermarket is Netto, only 3 minutes from the apartments. At the street corner, there is also little grocery shop ABC and a bit further a Żabka.

Nearby, you will find pharmacy „Pod Smokiem”.

A bit further (about 5 minutes on foot) there is shopping passage, where you will find the JAKUBOWSCY bakery (we recommend the cottage chesse patries), a butcher and delicatessen.

## MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

---

In Ustka, there is night medical assistance at the hospital (Mickiewicza 12).

The nearest ER is in hospital in Słupsk at Hubalczyków 1.

## TIME FOR LUNCH

---

For delicious fish, as well as Georgian and vegan cuisine, we recommend the restaurant MEDUZA at Benowskiego 10.

If you are in the mood for pizza or classic dishes with modern twist, visit LAGUNA, located on promenade at Bolesława Limanowskiego 8.

If you prefer choosing and customizing your own portions, we recommend FAMILIA restaurant, where meals are served by weight. The restaurant is located just block from apartments.

## A SWEET MOMENT

---

For delicious ice cream and waffles, we recommend BACIO. The cafe has several locations, including the main promenade square.

For fans of cinnamon rolls, FIKA at Bolesława Limanowskiego 6 is worth a visit.

For a longer walk or a short drive, BAR SŁOMKA in Orzechowo, located at the cliff and beach entrance, is a good destination.

Another worth visiting is MISTRAL cafe, where apart from delicious doughnuts and ice cream, you will also find artisanal Ustka fudge, which makes a great seaside souvenir.

For tea and coffee lovers, we recommend the tearoom (NIE)WINNA PIWNICZKA. We suggest setting aside more time for this visit, as the selection is impressive.

## SOUVENIRS

---

If you enjoy edible souvenirs, we recommend visiting RYBNE IMPERIUM, which offers a wide selection of fish preserves and canned goods from the local brand ŁOSOŚ. The store is located at Marynarki Polskiej 9.

At the tourist center at Marynarki Polskiej, you will find many souvenirs related to Ustka - from magnets and postcards to clothes, figurines and books. You will also find leaflets with current event and city maps.

## ATTRACTIONS IN USTKA

---

To feel the spirit of the town, we recommend a walk. Here's our suggested route:

After leaving the apartment, turn left, and soon you will see the historic town hall. Next to the town hall, turn right towards the historic church. It is worth stepping inside and paying attention to the organ. Organ concerts are held there, with schedules available on the city's website. From the church, turn left and you will find yourself on Ustka's main street, where all the restaurants and souvenir shops begin. Alternatively, you can cross the road near the church and turn right behind the dentist's office, leading directly to the port. Continue straight ahead, and you will reach the promenade and beach. Walking towards the port, you will also see the lighthouse, which is open to tourists, and the footbridge, which opens on the full hour for 20 minutes. You can cross it to the western part of the city, where the beach is less crowded.

For history lovers, BUNKRY BLUCHERA are a must-see. You can explore former German bunkers, try field kitchen meals, and play ASG.

## ATTRACTIONS IN USTKA

---

To truly experience the seaside, we recommend a boat cruise. In the port, you will find two places offering such trips. A sunset cruise is particularly beautiful, as the sky takes stunning colors.

For those seeking adrenaline, there are also speedboat rides available at the footbridge in the port. These rides take place every hour after the footbridge closes.

Families with children should check the Ustka cultural center's website. They organize many children's activities, including theater performances.

Art lovers may enjoy the Baltic Gallery of Contemporary Art, located at the eastern port.

At the entrance to Ustka, you will also find the Brine Graduation Tower - a perfect place to relax and breathe deeply.

## ATTRACTIONS IN THE AREA

---

In Swołowo (20 minutes by car), there is the "Land in Checks". This open-air museum features traditional half-timbered houses. You can experience the atmosphere of an old Polish village, explore cottages, enjoy Polish cuisine, and children can take part in traditional village games.

Another open-air museum is located in Kluki, this place is focusing on the tradition of the Slovincians (50 minutes by car).

Ustka is located near the Słowiński National Park. Check the park's website for attractions suitable for everyone.

For the youngest, the Dinosaur Park in Łeba (1.5 hours by car) may be an exciting destination.
